CHURCH LANE - ROAD CLOSURE

Monday 10 July to Friday 21 July

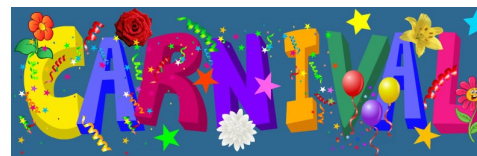
There will be a KCC road closure at the end of Church Lane near Faversham Road. There will be NO access from Faversham Road/Seasalter Cross up Church Lane to Thanet Way.

There will be full access from Thanet Way down to Heritage Close and along to The Orchards.

This road closure is for the safe use of a crane and deliveries of timber frame and connections for South East Water and Southern Water at the site next to The Orchards.

The closure is 24/7 during the week.

Road will be opened for the weekend of 15/16 July.
