GOD'S EASTER PEOPLE

Rev Rachel Webbley writes..



What does it mean to be God's Easter people? Perhaps that will mean a very early start on Easter day to welcome the dawn, lighting an early fire on Duncan Downs beacon. We are welcoming not just the actual morning, and remembering the first Easter day when Mary met the risen Jesus. We are also opening ourselves again to the resurrection life that heals and brings hope of new life, even beyond what we think is possible or practical or reasonable or acceptable. We dare to venture out of our own tombs into the bright light of a new day. We can be quite comfortable with the familiarity of our 'tombs' – they are quite safe places, and don't demand the effort of change that Jesus' life in all its fullness offers us.

Sometimes others have placed all kinds of fears and barriers at the doors of our 'tombs', so we are afraid to open ourselves in new ways to God's Spirit. Easter people are able to ask the questions that start to open new pathways, trusting in God's surprising answers. Easter people don't give up on their vision when things don't work to our timetable. Easter people take God seriously, and take the suffering of the vulnerable seriously, but are too full of joy to take themselves too seriously. Easter people don't deny the reality of sorrow in our world. Instead, we proclaim that death does not have the last word and that joy comes in the morning. Alleluia!
