Please continue to pray for Lise, Andrew and for the children's ministry here and across the Team churches as they take up their new roles.

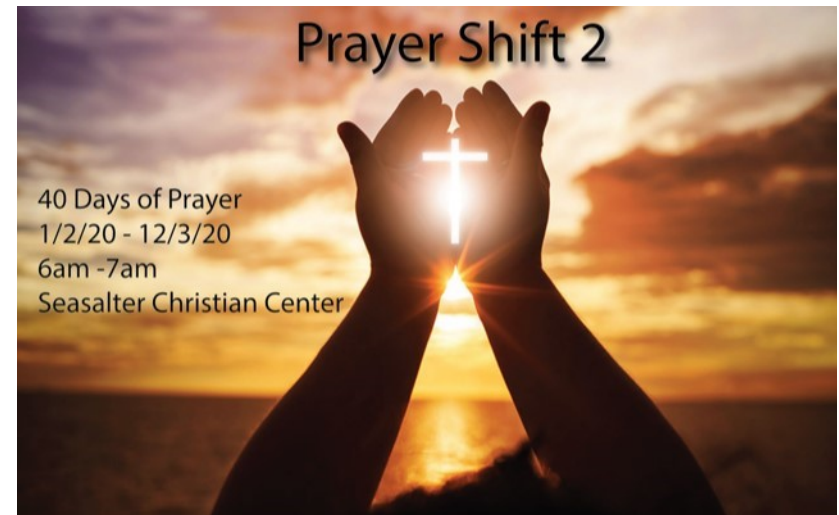
