# Changes - face coverings and refreshments at SCC

From Sunday September 12th, we are going to begin offering refreshments after both the services (8.45 and 10.30 new pattern).

From this point, with masks being optional and in many cases not being worn in most public places and restaurants/hospitality spaces now, and as most have been vaccinated, it will be <u>optional</u> at SCC for people to wear face coverings in the building.

Whether people prefer to wear a face covering or not in the building, regularly or from time to time, they should feel affirmed in their choice.

We will continue to take care of each other by:

- Committing to not attending church gatherings or services if we are at all unwell or know we may have been exposed to the virus (e.g. someone we have been with tests positive) until we know we are not infected.
- Washing hands/using sanitiser regularly as we come and go in the building.
- Respecting each other's space, continuing to use the coloured dots for the time being while we navigate that.
- Crucially, keeping the building very well ventilated on a Sunday (and in the grand history of Anglican churches, you may need to bring an extra layer or coat to wear in case as we head into the colder months)
- Continuing to receive Holy Communion in one kind only (bread/wafer) for the time being.

Importantly, we will continue to monitor the situation and will be fully prepared to reinstate more restrictive measures again if necessary.
