Confirmation

On 6 June, 7 pm at St Mary's Reculver, a number of people from the churches in our Deanery will be Confirmed. Confirmation is an opportunity for people who were baptised/Christened as a young child or baby to affirm for themselves the promises that were made on their behalf by parents and godparents. It can be a significant step on the journey of faith. At this special service, the bishop lays hands on your head and asks God's Holy Spirit to strengthen you as you commit to live God's way. Baptism

Being baptised is an important step on the journey of faith in Jesus Christ. It's a wonderful experience and there's no age limit.
